

HYGIENE AT THE POOL

Maintaining a healthy environment through prevention



In 2012, an innovative aquatic centre was inaugurated in Canazei: "Dòlaondes". This centre, including its 6 pools, is regularly monitored and sanitized according to hygiene regulations which include:

- *The water in the swimming pools is kept clean by ongoing chlorination.*
- *Special UV lamps are used to provide additional intensive water disinfection.*
- *Every night, the pools' floors are thoroughly cleansed by a special cleaning robot.*
- *The centre's showers, bathroom facilities, walls, and floors are disinfected on a daily basis.*
- *A specific anti-fungal disinfectant has been placed at the pool entrance in order for feet and pool slippers to be cleansed before entering the pool area. This disinfectant is also used to clean all surface areas around the pools.*

We go to great lengths to maintain a clean & safe environment for our guests. But bear in mind that this warm & humid space is an ideal breeding ground for fungal growth, so we need your help to keep it as clean as possible. Please follow these easy rules:



1. SHOWER.

Please shower before you enter the pool.

2. DISINFECT YOUR FEET AND SLIPPERS

Please dip your feet/slippers into the anti-fungal pools at the pool entrance.



3. WEAR POOL SLIPPERS.

This is a good way to avoid contact with any fungal bacteria.

4. ALWAYS WEAR A BATHING CAP.

Help us to keep the pool water clean and the filtering system void of hair.
